Winter ExComm Meeting Minutes December 11, 2012

Meeting called to order 9 am.

Quorum has been met (Ryan)

Approval of meeting agenda

Business minutes approved after addition of one item: two committee vacancies. Paul first, Jesse second

Treasurer's report (Dan Brauch)

Fiscal year 2013 is just underway with only two expenditures to date (Tax preparation fees of \$497 and liability insurance payment of \$150). Currently, checking balance is at \$35,508 and savings balance is at \$12,133. With investment fund value of approximately \$13,047, total chapter balances at \$60,689. Paul noted that we can move money from checking to endowment fund after annual meeting as annual meeting could have some big upfront costs.

Chapter taxes update (Paul Gerrity) Done!

Discussion of FY13 budget (Ryan Fitzpatrick)

We are sitting pretty well on our accounts. We could add to our endowment funds. Investment funds, we could add too, but it has tanked since we put money in. If membership has other ideas, bring up. Jesse mentioned INTL Kokanee Workshop in February (4<sup>th</sup>-7th). Ryan suggested that membership can discuss potential assistance of funds at annual meeting. Endowment funds are approved for support of CSU and University of Wyoming sub-units. Need to increase VP travel budget to \$1500 for Paul to travel to WD meeting.

2013 Annual meeting update (Ryan Fitzpatrick)

Marriott hotel best deal, will look at rooms this afternoon, contract worked out.

Open committee positions

Two open committee positions: Raffle and AV equipment committee chairs.

Student subunit reports (CSU – Eric Gardunio, UW- Phil Branigan)

Eric Gardunio: Tyler Swarr (tyler swarr@msn.com) is new CSU chapter president for next year. Chapter is looking to have derby in April and is working on Boyd Lake native fishes study. Student chapter has a new t-shirt design for and have shirts on sale now! Chris Kraft is working on student social for annual meeting and is working to obtain donated beer from New Belgium brewery. Chapter is working with Avogandro's Number to have annual meeting student social there. Also working with Coopersmiths (if social was held there, chapter could not bring in donated beer) or center for fine arts photography (would be fee of \$300 but would do own food and beer). Chapter is working on filing taxes, but IRS does not know who chapter is (Matt Kondratieff was doing taxes for

a while). Chapter is working to reapply for FEIN, but there may be a tax penalty. Ryan indicated that the CO/WY Chapter could cover any penalties to get the student chapter taxes completed.

Phil Branigan did not attend ExComm, but it was reported that student chapter membership has been good.

### Committee reports

- Arrangements (Ryan Fitzpatrick)
- Chapter archivist (Greg Anderson)
  - o Ryan has some edits for Fall Excomm meeting that he will provide to Dan who will then submit to Greg.
- Continuing education (Bobby Compton, Jesse Lepak)
  - O Scoped out several alternatives for 2013 continuing education sessions. A (cutthroat) genetic workshop was considered, but Jessica Metcalf not available and Kevin Rogers was not interested in instructing. Also have been working on a session on water law and water rights principles. Bobby mentioned that Tom Veneer is WY in stream flow coordinator and could be on panel (does speak around country). Discussed other potential speakers and potential of having a panel for session. Rick Henderson mentioned that the USFS has two water law folks on staff and that he could contact to see if they could participate. Discussed asking fish people with water law background to present, not lawyers. Could put together session with no caps. Jesse would like to put together proposal (a couple paragraphs) for the next week or so to send out for discussion.

  - Steve Gale stepped down after 6 years on committee but still will be helping; Boyd now has access to email list and account. Nathan discussed getting new copy of membership from parent chapter. Discussed waiting until a little later since many will renew in January or getting list from 2012 instead (could do both). Mentioned that Steve Gale wants to set up face book page.

Results in registration fees of \$155 for regular members. Ryan and Kevin will be working to have 123signup registration set up in next week and will get final numbers entered into web site. Ryan expected open registration to begin next week and will get announcement out to list serve when the 123signup page is ready. Early Registration date is planned for the first week of February.
